St Lawrence Formation

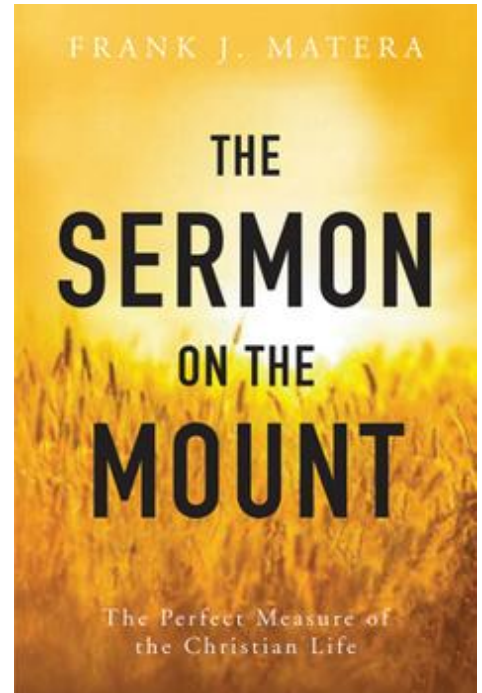
